This job description on should not be interpreted as all-inclusive. It is intended to identify the essential functions and minimum qualifications of this job. The incumbent(s) may be required to perform job-related responsibilities and tasks other than those stated in this job description. Nothing in this job description restricts management's right to assign or reassign job related responsibilities and tasks to this job at any time. Certain functions are understood to be essential; these include, but are not limited to, attendance, getting along with others, working a full shift, and dealing with and working under stress. Any essential function of this class will be evaluated as necessary should an incumbent/applicant be unable to perform the essential function or requirement due to a disability as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), reasonable accommodation for the specific disability will be made for the incumbent/applicant when possible.

JOB OBJECTIVE: Performs skilled work in the application of approved chemicals to control immature and adult mosquitos. Work is performed under the general supervision of the Mosquito Control Director and is reviewed through the inspection of records submitted and direct observation. Employees must be able to work day shift or night shift. Work may require performing diagnostics, adjustments, repairs, and/or overhauls of small engines used to power mosquito spray units and related equipment. This position is seasonal/part-time.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- 1. Stores, mixes, and applies pesticides in strict accordance with state and federal regulations
- 2. Uses safety equipment provided and maintains daily records
- 3. Conducts field inspections to detect the presence of mosquitoes, sets and retrieves mosquito traps
- 4. Learns to identify various mosquito species in both the adult and larval stages
- 5. Maintains current knowledge of advancements in mosquito control field through self-study and professional training courses
- 6. Responsible for driving a regular size pick-up truck with a mosquito spray unit mounted in bed of truck
- 7. Conducts field surveys using modern techniques to determine mosquito population throughout
- 8. Use of light traps for larval collection and conduct landing rate counts
- 9. Repair and maintain gasoline engines used to power equipment such as mosquito spray units
- 10. Adjust points, valves, carburetors, distributors, and spark plug gaps, using feeler gauges
- 11. Reassemble engines after repair or maintenance work is complete
- 12. Record repairs made, time spent, and parts used
- 13. Perform routine maintenance such as cleaning and oiling parts, honing cylinders, and tuning ignition systems
- 14. Test and inspect engines to determine malfunctions, to locate missing and broken parts, and to verify repairs using diagnostic instruments
- 15. Assists in routine maintenance of vehicles
